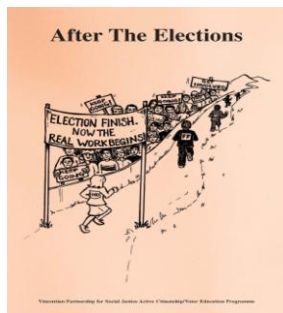
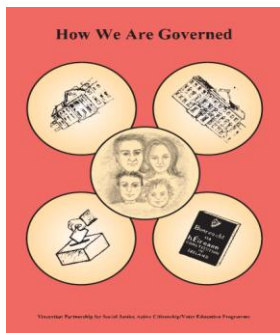


Active Citizenship Workshops Between and After Elections



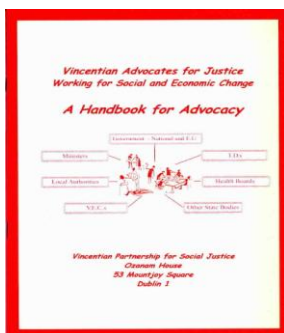
After the Elections

This programme helps participants to get to know who are the key people in Dail Eireann, their local TDs and how to identify issues that are of concern to them and how to present this issue to their TD.



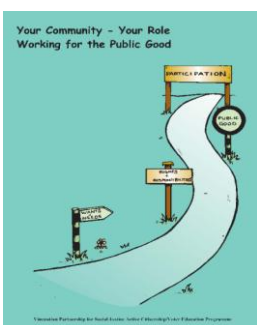
How we are Governed

This explores how we are governed from a local level to Presidency and include our membership of the European Union. It looks at the need for local government and councillors and how local government functions.



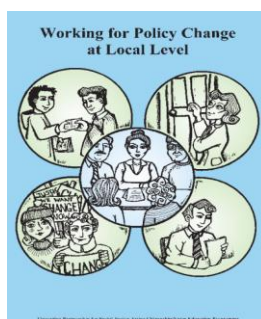
Advocacy
