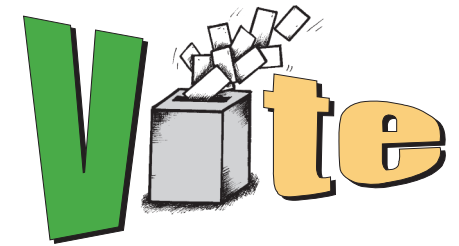

How do I Register?*

Still Not Too Late To Register to Vote

- Many people do not vote - Voters make things happen – if you want change it is important to Vote – Every Vote counts!
- People struggled to get the right to vote. In some parts of the world people still do not have the right. In Ireland we should exercise our right
- Low voting areas lose out – high voting areas benefit and get more attention from politicians
- We are responsible for the kind of politicians we get – Don't complain if you don't Vote!

How Do I Register to Vote?

In order to have your name on the Register of Electors it is necessary for people who are not already registered to complete the registration form which is available online (www.checktheregister.ie) and also from local council offices, libraries, post offices and Garda stations

Send the completed form to the Franchise Section of your local council before the November closing date

If you need to register after the November closing date get a Supplementary Registration Form available on line (www.checktheregister.ie) and also from local council offices, libraries, post offices and Garda stations. Send the completed form to your local council

When the election date is announced and if you are not registered, complete the Supplementary Registration Form, have it signed and stamped by a Garda, and send it to your local council office at least 15 days before the date of the election
